









Public Notice: Camden County Residents Urged to Wear Facemasks

All Camden County residents are urged to wear facemasks to slow the spread of COVID-19 in our community.

Entrance to specified local government buildings may require a facemask. Residents are encouraged to use online or telephone services before visiting an office in-person.



Additionally, all Camden County residents are strongly encouraged to follow recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) including:

- Practicing social distancing by staying at least six (6) feet apart from others;
- Wearing a cloth face covering when social distancing is not possible;
- Washing your hands often with soap and water or using hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol:
- Cleaning frequently touched surfaces and objects (like cell phones);
- Abstaining from touching eyes, nose, and mouth;
- · Covering coughs and sneezes; and
- Staying home if you are sick.
