Two Rivers Gun Range Grand Opening

WOODBINE, Ga. – November 2, 2021 – The Camden County Board of Commissioners is pleased to join the Georgia Department of Natural Resources in welcoming the public to celebrate the Grand Opening of Two Rivers Gun Range at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, November 12, 2021.

Participants may tour the facility, including the 20-station Pistol Range with steel targets at known distances from 15 to 25 yards as well as the 12-station Rifle Range with digital Kongsberg Target System and known distances at 50, 100, and 200 yards. Please note that due to the Grand Opening, there will be no live fire until 2:00 p.m.

“We are excited for Camden County residents to join us for the grand opening of Two Rivers Gun Range,” said Deputy County Administrator Shawn Boatright. “We appreciate their patience with the weather-related delays and hope they will enjoy this facility for years to come.”

Two Rivers Gun Range is located in extreme southwest Camden County on Georgia Highway 110, approximately one mile north of the intersection with Georgia Highway 40 at 1006 Georgia Highway 110, Folkston, Georgia, 31537. Although the address is listed as Folkston, the range is located in Camden County.
