Your letter indicates that a contracted vendor has now confirmed my statements that the men and women of the Camden County Sheriff's Office have been and are currently underpaid. As you know, I have been working to correct this for some time. If the commission is able to raise their pay, I urge you to do so without delay.

As you acknowledge, in your letter, "...we cannot by law set the compensation or [Sheriff's Office] employees..." However, as I said some three weeks ago, I encourage, welcome, and support any pay increases for the men and women of Camden County Sheriff's Office who protect our citizens
