COURTROOM ATTIRE

- To maintain the dignity of the court, appropriate attire should be worn during your visit to the Camden County Courthouse. Men are expected to wear a shirt with a collar (***shirt tails must be tucked in***) & long pants (***jeans without holes/cuts are acceptable***). Ladies are expected to wear a dress, or a blouse & skirt or long pants (***jeans without holes/cuts are acceptable***). Shoes should be worn in the courtroom at all times (***flip-flops are not acceptable***). Shorts, T-shirts, tank tops or revealing clothing are not acceptable courtroom attire. All non-religious headwear must be removed while in the courtroom.

COURTROOM ETIQUETTE

- Cellular phones & electronic devices are prohibited in the courthouse. Court security officers are authorized to open & inspect any item carried into the courtroom.
- All parties present in the courtroom, unless physically challenged, must rise when the judge enters & remain standing until the presiding judge invites everyone to be seated. Similarly, when court adjourns, all parties present in the courtroom stand in place until the judge is no longer visible. Doorways & passageways should be kept clear at all times.
- When court is in session, no one should be heard except for the parties before the bench & there shall be no cross-talk between the parties. All comments should be directed to the judge. If it is necessary to speak with another party, please step outside. However, repeated entrances & departures are to be avoided.
- Parties are expected to behave in a professional, civilized manner at all times.
