Flooding Due to Increased Water Levels of the St. Marys River in the Flea Hill Area of Camden County

Woodbine, GA – August 28, 2008: Due to the amount of rainfall caused by Tropical Storm Fay, Camden County residents in the Flea Hill area including, Springhill Court, the southern end of Springhill Road and Flea Hill Road have experienced flooding due to the swell of the St. Marys River. Camden County EMA Director Mark Crews has marked roads in this area in an effort to determine when water levels are receding. At this time an exact time is unknown as to when the St. Marys River will crest, but it is believed that waters should begin to recede within the next 12-36 hours. Public Works Director Scott Brazell has marked the affected roadways to enable public safety personnel to access this area. It is asked that only those who must travel these roadways do so, otherwise please refrain from driving on the
