Camden County Public Service Authority (PSA) Receives Grant from the Baseball Tomorrow Fund

Grant Funds Awarded for Youth Baseball and Softball Equipment

WOODBINE, GEORGIA – March 2, 2017 – Camden County Public Service Authority (PSA) Leisure Services announced today that it was recently awarded a grant in the amount of \$32,000 from the Baseball Tomorrow Fund (BTF). The grant provides funding for the purchase of baseball and softball player safety and training equipment.

PSA provides leisure and recreational opportunities for the citizens of Camden County. It also serves families associated with the Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay, offering recreational T-ball, baseball, and softball. In addition to its in-house league, PSA facilities serve travel teams, outside leagues and tournaments. The BTF grant will support the growth of the program by accommodating the organization to conduct multiple practices on the available fields. It will also facilitate a new fall baseball and t-ball program.

The PSA is responsible for the maintenance of 27 other parks and recreational facilities throughout the county. In addition, they manage Mosquito Control, facilities maintenance, and roadside mowing.
